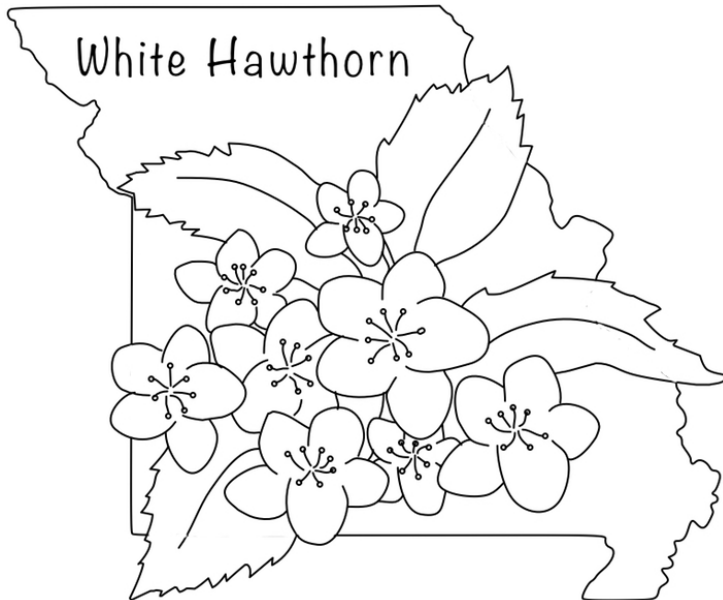


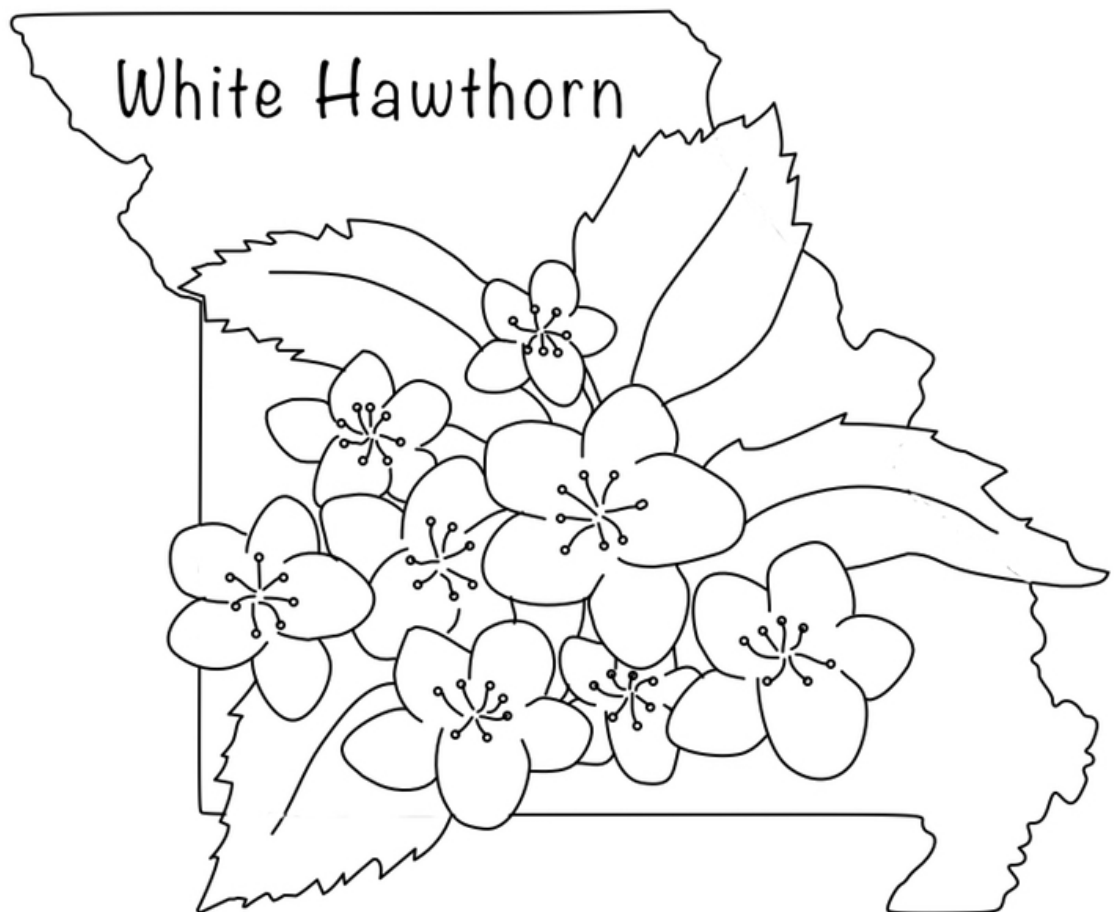
# Missouri Flower Embroidery Pattern {White Hawthorn}



# Full Size Design

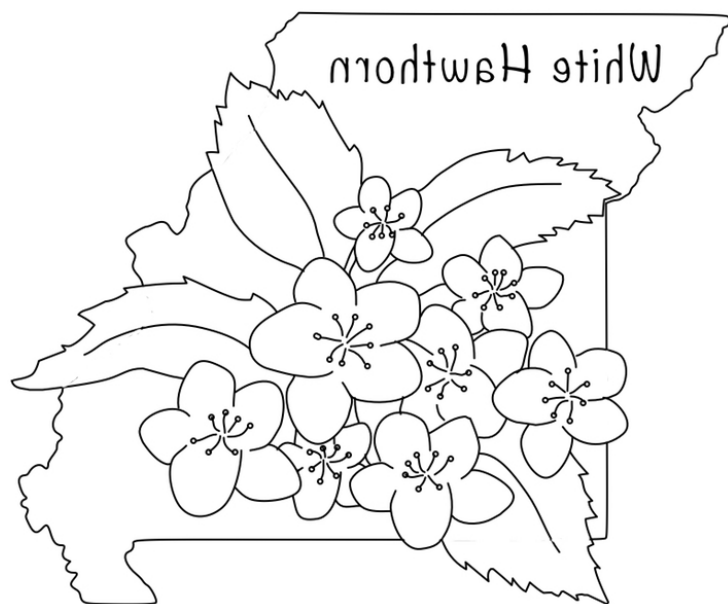


Fits 5 or 6-Inch Hoop



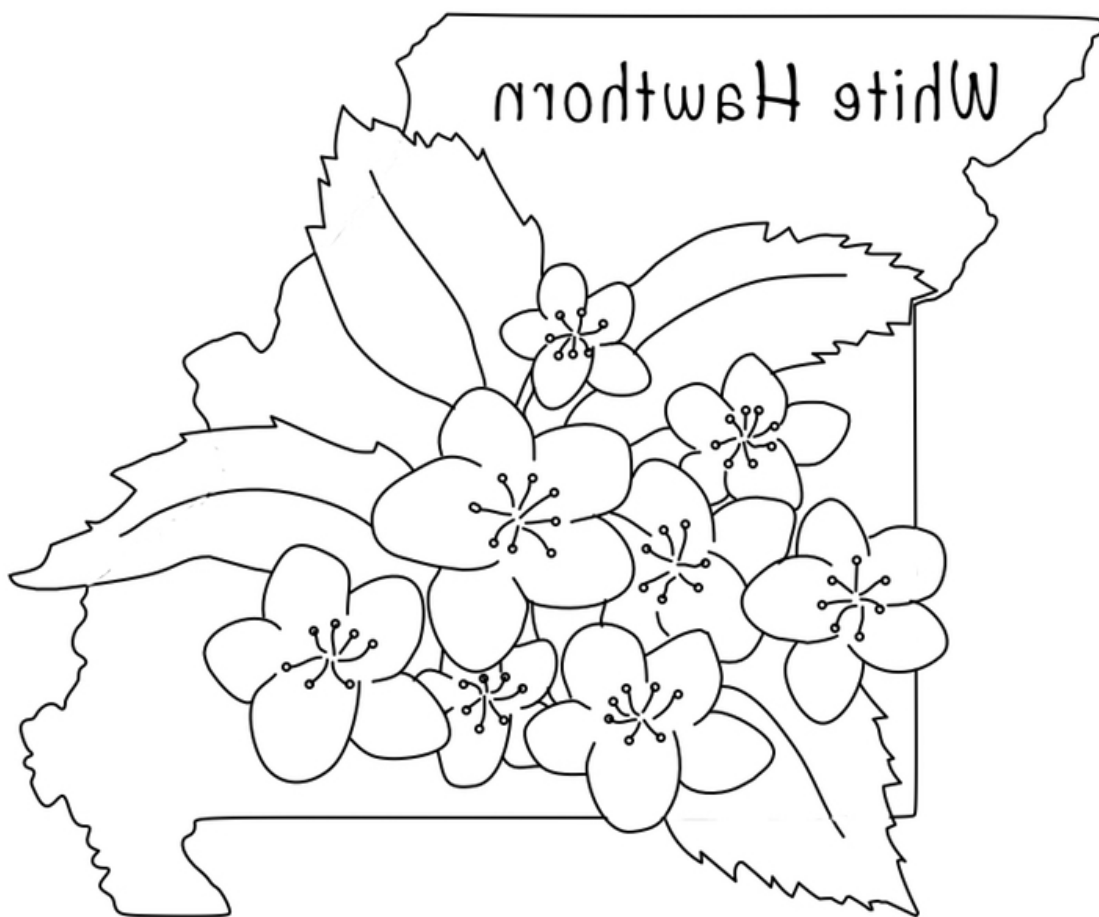
Fits 7 or 8-Inch Hoop

Stitch - Split, 4 strands

Color - DMC 904

Stitch - Back, 4 strands

Flower Petals:

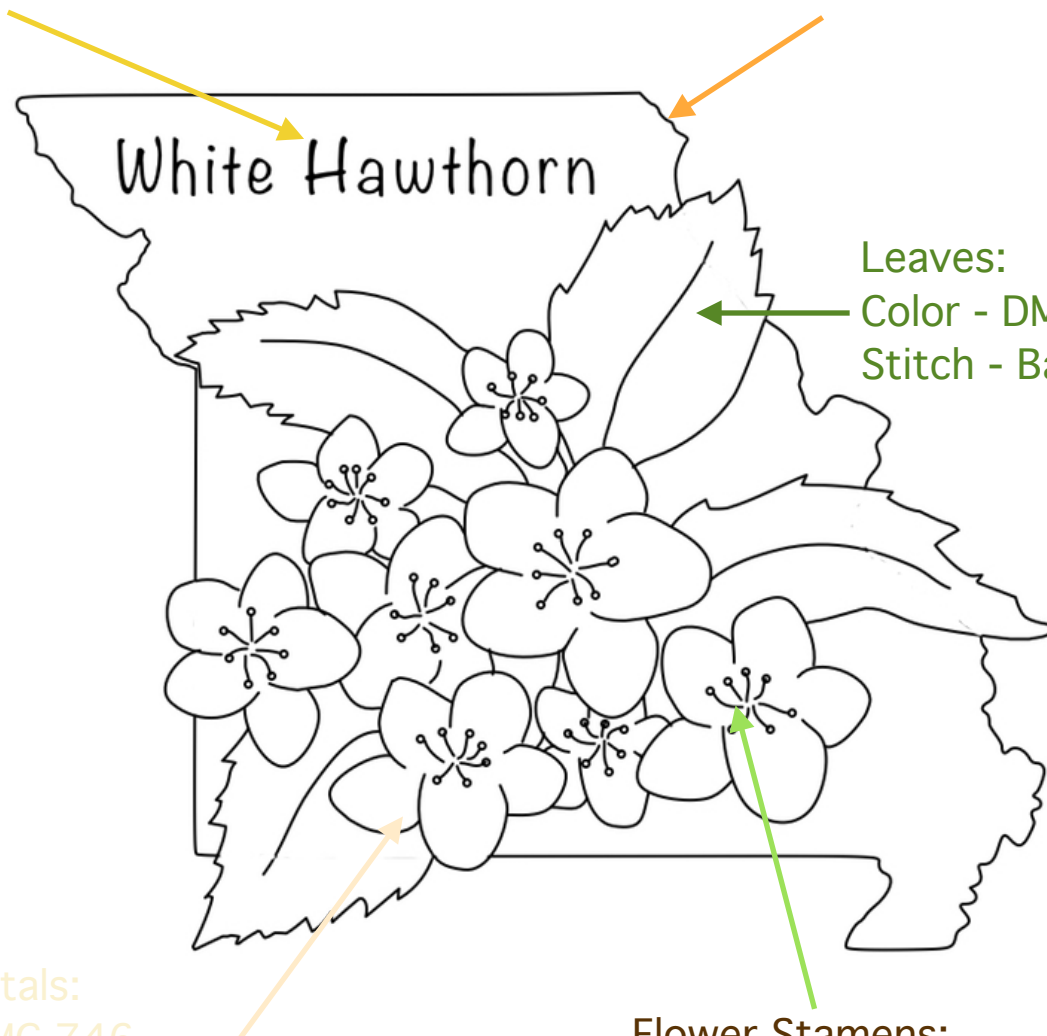
Color - DMC 746

Stitch - Stem, 3 strands

Flower Stamens:

Color - DMC 477 & 3012

Stitch - Back & French Knot,  
2 strands



# Pattern Transfer Instructions

## Light Table/ Window:

Place the pattern on a light table or tape it to a bright window. Position the fabric on top and secure in place. Trace the pattern onto the fabric using a water or air soluble transfer pen.

## Dressmaker's Carbon:

Carbon Paper can be found at many fabric stores. It comes in both light and dark colors. To use, secure your fabric to a flat surface, cover with a piece of carbon paper and place the printed pattern on top. Trace the pattern using a pencil or fine tipped pen. Press firmly for best results. Remove the printed pattern and the carbon paper to reveal the fabric with the transferred pattern.

## Iron On Transfer Pencil or Pen:

This method uses an iron on transfer pen or pencil which can be found at most fabric/sewing stores. First, print the REVERSE IMAGE pattern. Trace the pattern with the iron on pencil or pen. Place the pattern, traced side down, on top of your fabric. Press a hot iron on top of the fabric for 5-10 seconds. Do not move the iron around. Gently lift an edge of the fabric to check that the design has transferred before removing the fabric.

\* This method will leave permanent marks that need to be covered with embroidery or they will show on the finished piece.

# Materials List

- Fabric Square in appropriate size for your pattern & hoop size choice:  
Choose a fabric with a loose to medium weave such as a cotton, muslin, or flour sack. The above example uses a white muslin, but don't be afraid to try a darker color.

- Embroidery Hoop:  
Size 5,6,7, or 8

- Embroidery Needle:  
Size 7 or 9

- Water Soluble Pen or other items for pattern transfer.  
(See Transfer Instructions)

- Small Scissors

- DMC Embroidery Floss:  
3821, 977, 904, 477,  
3021, 746

The floss colors are for guidance. Feel free to substitute or change the colors. Have fun and make the pattern your own!
